Observation or Inference??

"The condors are fighting!"

Observation: The condors are holding each end of the rabbit and pulling in opposite directions.

"The macaw is looking at us."

Observation: The front of the macaw's head is pointed toward in our direction.

"The squirrel is looking for food."

Observation: The squirrel is using its front paws to dig into the ground.

Observation

Information obtained through the use of one or more senses

Inference

A judgement or conclusion made as a result of one or more observations.
